Meeting at the EU Parliament


We are sharing the following exciting updates for this year:

- The inaugural EACLIPT conference will be held 2-3 November 2018 in Linköping, Sweden. We will have keynote lectures of well-known European clinical psychologists, but also panel discussions around essential topics of our field (e.g., How to integrate evidence-based new developments and non-CBT approaches into EACLIPT? How to increase the political impact of clinical psychology worldwide and in Europe?).
- *Save the date* for the First official European congress on clinical psychology and psychological treatment of EACLIPT, 31 Oct - 02 Nov 2019 in Dresden/Germany (website will soon be released). This is supposed to become our first, large European congress. Dresden is perfectly located for such a congress: with a true European history, called the "Florence at the river Elbe", its airport is easily reachable from Western and Eastern European countries, from south and north.
